(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the regular classes at each event and is open to all breeders and owners of Bulldogs. Classes will be divided by age and sex and all classes exclude Champions. The dog may be shown by handler, agent, or owner. Each dog or bitch MUST be entered in a Regular Class at this show. Entry fee is \$15 for each dog; each event and entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for Additional Classes. Sweepstakes wins carry no AKC championship points.

Classes in the Sweepstakes will be divided by sex into the following age categories:

Puppy Dogs (6 months & under 9 months)	Puppy Bitches (6 months & under 9 months)
Puppy Dogs (9 months & under 12 months)	Puppy Bitches (9 months & under 12 months)

Other Important Information

**NO Adult Dogs or Puppies are to be sold within the show site.
Only dogs that are entered in the show are allowed within the show limits.**

ADDITIONAL RULES

If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the club and committee, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

A recording fee of 50 cents and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. These fees are to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class at these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Sec. 2). (There is NO Recording Fee of Event Service Fee for Sweepstakes or Special Attractions).

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to each returned check.

No space will be provided for unentered dogs at these shows. No unentered dogs or puppies will be allowed inside the show limits.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. The Club and its' Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obliged to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. The Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

A dog which, according to its owners' records, has completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

The club will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the results of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody, and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. The club will not be responsible for injury to any person attending this show.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Trophies and prizes must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

American Kennel Club Rules & Regulations will govern these events and exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Premium List.

Exhibitors must not wear pins or badges identifying them with any club or organization. Crates and grooming tables will not be allowed within 10 feet of the rings. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring.

The Show Secretary and the show-giving club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of breed is over.

The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-By Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.
