Amateur Owner Handler Dogs

(Effective as of 1/1/2009) Chapter 3, Section 7 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows "The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13)."

Amateur Owner Handler Bitches

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

USE OF RAMPS WITH TERRIER BREEDS

The entire entry in these breeds are to be examined on the ground or on a ramp at the sole discretion of the judge: Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers and Staffordshire Bull Terriers.

This list may be revised from time to time, and the current list can be found on the AKC website in Judging Operations.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Event Secretary prior to the day of the show. AKC approval is not required.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

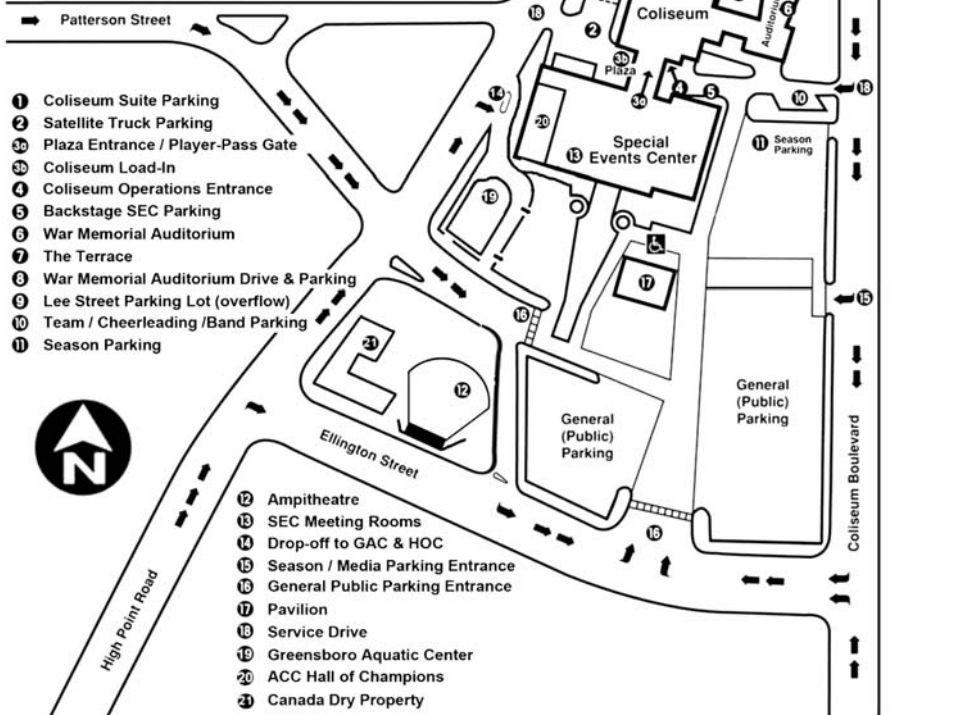
Hotel/Motel regulations notice to dog owners / exhibitors!

The following rules have been established for the good of all exhibitors concerned. Failure to comply could result in an event committee action (chapter 5, section 2 of "rules applying to Registration and Discipline").

1. Plastic sheeting is to be placed under every crate in hotel rooms. This will keep carpets clean and dry. Plastic sheeting for each crate will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to provide their own.
2. DOGS MUST BE CRATED WHEN OWNER IS OUT OF THE ROOM.
3. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE HOTEL, LOBBIES, OR ON HOTEL GROUNDS. ROOMS AND LOBBY MUST BE KEPT CLEAN OF DOG DEBRIS.
4. Dogs should be "exercised" in designated areas on motel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after his own dog and dispose of waste in designated trash cans. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to find out from the innkeeper where these areas and cans are.
5. No dog may be bathed in the hotel due to severe clogging problems in the drain pipes.
6. Rooms will be inspected daily by members of the hotel staff and observed violations or damages will be reported to the hotel management and/or the Investigative Committee.
7. The Investigative Committee, working with a fair and equitable system, is charged with investigating complaints.
8. Each dog owner/registrant is expected to cooperate with the Investigative Committee, hopefully settling damage claims on the spot, or else must be willing to furnish information such as Insurance policy numbers and other required pertinent information.
9. Should a hotel/motel for cause, deem it necessary to cancel room privileges, the registrant agrees to forego legal actions against the clubs, MB-F, Inc., and the hotel/motel.
10. As an exhibitor, I am aware that violations may also be referred to the Event Committee if written charges are preferred. If such charges are upheld by the Event Committee, it may lead to suspension from future show privileges.
11. Limit one (1) dog per room, OR AT THE DISCRETION OF THE INNKEEPER.

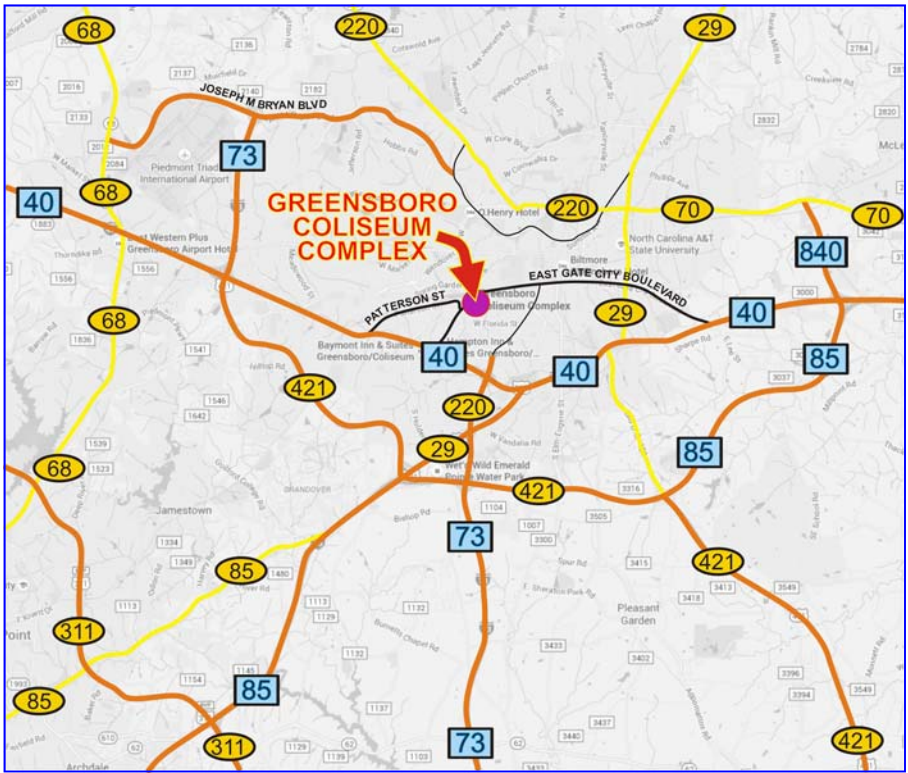

DIRECTIONS TO EVENT SITE

Directions from all main highways are clearly marked with signs to the Greensboro Coliseum.

I-85 SOUTH/I-40 WEST FROM BURLINGTON: From I-40 West take Exit 131 to I-40 Business West. Follow I-40 Business West (7.5 miles) to Exit 36-A, I-40 Business West. Follow I-40 Business West (1 mile) to Exit 218B, Freeman Mill Road. Go .3 miles and turn left on Coliseum Boulevard. One mile to the Complex on your left, turn left onto Ellington Street and right onto the main entrance.

I-85 NORTH FROM CHARLOTTE: On I-85 North from Charlotte, take Exit 120-A to access I-85 Business North. Continue 2 miles to Exit 35-B Highway US 220 North. Proceed 1.8 miles and turn left on Coliseum Boulevard. One mile to the Complex on your left, turn left onto Ellington Street and right into the main entrance.

I-40 EAST FROM WINSTON-SALEM: On I-40 East from Winston-Salem, take Exit 212 to I-40 Business East. *Continue 3.5 miles on I-40 Business East to Exit 216 Patterson Street. Continue straight ahead for 2.4 miles to the Coliseum Complex. *Continue 5 miles on I-40 Business East to Exit 217 High Point Road. Turn left at top of ramp and continue 1 mile on High Point Road to Ellington Street. Turn right for .5 miles and enter Complex through main entrance.

HIGHWAY 220 NORTH FROM ASHEBORO: Highway 220 North to Greensboro turns into Freeman Mill Road. Stay on Freeman Mill Road. After crossing I-85 Business, proceed 1.8 miles and turn left onto Coliseum Boulevard. 1 mile to the Complex on your left, turn left onto Ellington Street and right onto the main entrance.

HIGHWAY 220 SOUTH FROM VIRGINIA: Coming south on Highway 220 (Battleground Avenue), turn right on Benjamin Parkway, then right at the next light (Holden Road). Follow Holden Road several miles and turn left on Patterson Avenue. Patterson Avenue intersects Lee Street and the Coliseum complex.

Date of closing is WEDNESDAY, NOON EDT JULY 29, 2015,

at the address designated for event processing, after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing date, except as provided for in Chapter 11 Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules. Fax entries that are received incomplete or unable to be read will not be accepted. The proof of transmission is not proof for verifying faxed entries. Telephone and emailed entries are not accepted.

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds. Returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards must be made good before the dog (s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, or submits payment by credit card that is declined, will be required to pay a fine of \$25 in addition to the entry fees for which check or checks were issued or for charges to the declined credit card. The entry fee plus the \$25 shall then be paid by cash, money order, or cashier's check. Subsequent returned checks or declined credit cards from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete or entries received without correct fee amounts will not be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks including wrong information, entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.

Entries not on official AKC forms or downloaded or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form and/or not within the official AKC entry size are NOT acceptable.

The Carolina Terrier Association does not agree to arbitrate claims for these events as set forth on the official American Kennel Club entry form.
