Hotel/Motel regulations notice to dog owners / exhibitors!

The following rules have been established for the good of all exhibitors concerned. Failure to comply could result in an event committee action (chapter 5, section 2 of "rules applying to Registration and Discipline").

- Plastic sheeting is to be placed under every crate in hotel rooms. This will keep carpets clean and dry. Plastic sheeting for each crate will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to provide their own.
- DOGS MUST BE CRATED WHEN OWNER IS OUT OF THE ROOM.
- 3. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE HOTEL, LOBBIES, OR ON HOTEL GROUNDS. ROOMS AND LOBBY MUST BE KEPT CLEAN OF DOG DEBRIS.
- 4. Dogs should be "exercised" in designated areas on motel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after his own dog and dispose of waste in designated trash cans. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to find out from the innkeeper where these areas and cans are.
- 5. No dog may be bathed in the hotel due to severe clogging problems in the drain pipes.
- Rooms will be inspected daily by members of the hotel staff and observed violations or damages will be reported to the hotel management and/or the Investigative Committee.
- 7. The Investigative Committee, working with a fair and equitable system, is charged with investigating complaints.
- Each dog owner/registrant is expected to cooperate with the Investigative Committee, hopefully settling damage claims on the spot, or else must be willing to furnish information such as Insurance policy numbers and other required pertinent information.
- Should a hotel/motel for cause, deem it necessary to cancel room privileges, the registrant agrees to forego legal actions against the clubs, MB-F, Inc., and the hotel/motel.
- 10. As an exhibitor, I am aware that violations may also be referred to the Event Committee if written charges are preferred. If such charges are upheld by the Event Committee, it may lead to suspension from future show privileges.
- 11. Limit one (1) dog per room, OR AT THE DISCRETION OF THE INNKEEPER.

CLUSTER RULES

- ► No private exercise pens in the building(s).
- ► Leave "flashers" on when loading and unloading on the ramp. No parking in the loading and unloading area.
- ▶ Building will be available on Tuesday after the concessionaires are setup. For safety reasons no one is permitted to bring equipment/dogs in the building until setup is complete.
- ► Crates must be stacked. For this reason, no fabric crates permitted.
- ▶ Dogs may remain in the building overnight on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. All dogs left overnight must have an ID Tag and a local telephone number. The Cluster members assume NO liability for any animals or equipment left in the building.
- ▶ Doors open no later than 6:30 A.M. the morning of the show(s) and will be locked at 10:30 P.M. on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings.
- ► Grooming in designated areas only. Observe all aisle-ways as marked.
- Excessive use of space will be monitored by the Event Committee in order to provide a good experience for all exhibitors.
- Exhibitors are expected to observe all posted signs and to clean up after their dogs both inside and outside of the building.
- ▶ There is no space for un-entered dogs at these shows.
- ▶ Dogs must be removed from the building by 6:00 P.M. on Sunday.
- ► Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their tables. No private exercise pens allowed in the building. Aisles must be kept clear.
- ▶ No Flexi Leads or Mesh Crates will be allowed in show buildings. Please respect this!
- ▶ Danville Kennel Club, Inc., Greater Hickory Kennel Club, Inc. & Carolina Kennel Club, Inc. requests that crates be labeled with owner information for the safety of the dog.
- ▶ Use of shavings, or other comparable materials in private exercise pens in the parking lots must be swept up and bagged prior to leaving the show site. Plastic bags will be available at the club table.



WAIVER OF RIGHTS

The Carolina Terrier Association reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal. Event Secretary and Event Committee have authority to change rules for the safety and comfort of dogs and exhibitors. The Event Committee, in accordance with AKC Rules and Regulations, will deal with violations in this area.

DIRECTIONS TO EVENT SITE

Directions from all main highways are clearly marked with signs to the Greensboro Coliseum.

I-85 SOUTH/I-40 WEST FROM BURLINGTON: From I-40 West take Exit 131 to I-40 Business West. Follow I-40 Business West (7.5 miles) to Exit 36-A, I-40 Business West. Follow I-40 Business West (1 mile) to Exit 218B, Freeman Mill Road. Go .3 miles and turn left on Coliseum Boulevard. One mile to the Complex on your left, turn left onto Ellington Street and right onto the main entrance.

I-85 NORTH FROM CHARLOTTE: On I-85 North from Charlotte, take Exit 120-A to access I-85 Business North. Continue 2 miles to Exit 35-B Highway US 220 North. Proceed 1.8 miles and turn left on Coliseum Boulevard. One mile to the Complex on your left, turn left onto Ellington Street and right into the main entrance.

I-40 EAST FROM WINSTON-SALEM: On I-40 East from Winston-Salem, take Exit 212 to I-40 Business East. *Continue 3.5 miles on I-40 Business East to Exit 216 Patterson Street. Continue straight ahead for 2.4 miles to the Coliseum Complex. *Continue 5 miles on I-40 Business East to Exit 217 High Point Road. Turn left at top of ramp and continue 1 mile on High Point Road to Ellington Street. Turn right for .5 miles and enter Complex through main entrance.

<u>HIGHWAY 220 NORTH FROM ASHEBORO</u>: Highway 220 North to Greensboro turns into Freeman Mill Road. Stay on Freeman Mill Road. After crossing I-85 Business, proceed 1.8 miles and turn left onto Coliseum Boulevard. 1 mile to the Complex on your left, turn left onto Ellington Street and right onto the main entrance.

HIGHWAY 220 SOUTH FROM VIRGINIA: Coming south on Highway 220 (Battleground Avenue), turn right on Benjamin Parkway, then right at the next light (Holden Road). Follow Holden Road several miles and turn left on Patterson Avenue. Patterson Avenue intersects Lee Street and the Coliseum complex.
