Entries close 6:00 PM PDT WEDNESDAY, September 24, 2014, at the address designated for event processing, after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing date, except as provided for in Chapter 11 Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules. Fax entries that are received incomplete or unable to be read will not be accepted. The proof of transmission is not proof for verifying faxed entries. Telephone and emailed entries are not accepted.

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds. Returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards must be made good before the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, or submits payment by credit card that is declined, will be required to pay a fee of \$25 in addition to the entry fees for which check or checks were issued or for charges to the declined credit card. The entry fee plus the \$25 shall then be paid by cash, money order, or cashier's check. Subsequent returned checks or declined credit cards from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete or entries received without correct fee amounts will not be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks including wrong information, entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.

Entries not on official AKC forms or downloaded or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form and/or not within the official AKC entry size are NOT acceptable.

The Las Vegas Bulldog Club and the Bulldog Club of America, Div III do not agree to arbitrate claims for these events as set forth on the official American Kennel Club entry form.

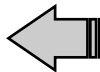

- \$50.00 refundable deposit for rooms with pets. All pets must be in crates or on leashes while being transported on the Riviera property.
- Incidental Charges: Individuals must provide a major credit card or cash deposit upon arrival at check-in. By law, at least one adult per room (over 21 years) and guest must present a valid ID (state drivers license, passport, etc.) at time of check-in.

FROM CALIFORNIA: 1-15 into Nevada and exit Sahara Avenue (Exit 40) and turn right 1 mile to Paradise Road (just past Las Vegas Blvd South). Turn right on Paradise Road. 0.5 miles to Riviera Boulevard. Turn right on Riviera Blvd to rear entrance of hotel. Turn right.

FROM UTAH: 1-15 into Nevada and exit Sahara Avenue (Exit 40) and turn 1.2 miles to Paradise Road (just past Las Vegas Blvd South) Turn right on Paradise Road. 0.5 miles to Riviera Blvd. Turn right on Riviera Blvd to rear entrance of hotel. Turn right.

FROM RENO: 95 to I-15 south (Exit 77) toward Los Angeles (downtown Las Vegas). Exit Sahara Avenue (Exit 40) and turn left 1.2 miles to Paradise Road (just past Las Vegas Blvd South). Turn right on Paradise Road. 0.5 mile to Riviera Blvd. Turn right on Riviera Blvd to rear entrance of hotel. Turn right.

FROM ARIZONA: 93 into Nevada. Past Boulder City, 93 will merge into 514. 515 go I-15 (downtown Las Vegas) I-15 south (Exit 77) toward Los Angeles. No overnight handicap parking is offered. All efforts will be made to park handicap requests closest to the Conference Center as possible. Handicap proof required.

No "set ups" allowed in Day of Show parking.

Exhibitors are responsible for THEIR garbage removal. **DO NOT LEAVE TRASH.**

MUST BE CLASS A OR CLASS C VEHICLE TO PARK IN OVERNIGHT RV AREA.

Arrangements have been made for RV sewage disposal with the RV Park adjacent to the Circus Circus Hotel. Sewage disposal fee is the sole responsibility of the RV owner.

All Riviera Hotel parking regulations must be adhered to at all times.

BOX-VANS:

Box-Van Parking is limited. No Electricity. Generators permitted.

Box Vans will be parked in a nearby designated area below the loading ramp.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. A recording fee of .50 cents and a Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Sec. 2). Trophies must be claimed the day of the show or be forfeited. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone and Telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries must be submitted on an American Kennel Club Official Entry Form or exact copy (both front & back) and must be signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or owner's Agent entering a dog or a class for which the dog is not eligible to compete. Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly. No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the show. Dogs must be ready for Judging: The club and its show secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. The Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. This club will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. The club will not be responsible for injury to any person attending this show. Exhibitors must not wear pins or badges identifying them with any club or organization. Crates and grooming tables will not be allowed within 10 feet of the rings. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring. Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over and the Show Secretary advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of breed is over.
