Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)

The Bred-By-Exhibitor Class shall be fore dogs that are:

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show
- Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of the entries for the show
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.
- In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Classes—Classes for dogs and bitches 6 years old and over. **Entry fee \$18.00**

Best of Breed Competition

Parade of Rescue Dogs: This is a non-competitive class, open to any Japanese Chin who was placed, adopted, or otherwise obtained other than being purchased from a breeder. Dog need not be entered in a regular class to enter. Spayed & neutered dogs are eligible. This class will occur after Best of Breed judging. **No Entry Fee.**

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two or more of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be entered separately in one of the other regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, and must be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get must be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry. The Stud Dog must be shown in the Ring with the Get. The Class will be judged on the merits of the Get. **Entry fee is \$18.00**

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and two or more of their Produce. It is not necessary that the Produce be under the same ownership as that of the Brood Bitch. The Brood Bitch must be entered separately in one of the other regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, and must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class. The Produce must be entered in one of the regular classes. The Brood

Bitch shall be considered as one entry. The Brood Bitch must be shown in the Ring with the Produce. The Class will be judged on the merits of the Produce. **Entry fee is \$18.00** As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

Brace: (two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handler) Dogs may be entered for Brace Competition for an additional **entry fee of \$18.00 per unit**. Dogs competing in the Brace Class must be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class. Brace Class must be noted on the entry form in the space of "Additional Classes". If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No.!", "Brace No. @", etc.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Entry is limited to 100 dogs at each show.

**Entries Close at 8:00 pm PDT on Wednesday, October 26, 2011
or when the limit has been reached, whichever is first.**

Nor-Cal Japanese Chin Fanciers does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official American Kennel Club entry form for these shows.

NO Adult Dogs or Puppies are to be sold within the show site. Only dogs that are entered in the show are allowed within the show limits.

ADDITIONAL RULES

If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the club and committee, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

A recording fee of 50 cents and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. These fees are to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class at these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Sec. 2). (There is NO Recording Fee of Event Service Fee for Sweepstakes or Special Attractions).

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to each returned check.

No space will be provided for unentered dogs at these shows. No unentered dogs or puppies will be allowed inside the show limits.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. The Club and its' Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obliged to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. The Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

A dog which, according to its owners' records, has completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

The club will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the results of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody, and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. The club will not be responsible for injury to any person attending this show.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Trophies and prizes must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

American Kennel Club Rules & Regulations will govern these events and exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Premium List.

Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Effective Jan. 1, 2010.

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1: No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

CORRECTION OR CHANGES TO ENTRIES: The specific changes listed in Ch. 11 Sec. 6 (ie: sex of a dog, transfers between age specific classes and "move ups" to BOB) or the Dog Show Rules are the **only** changes to the entries the event secretary is authorized to make **after closing of entries**. This rule is strictly enforced by the American Kennel Club. **Please check your entries carefully.** Corrections to entries may be made by the event secretary prior to the closing of entries if such correction is submitted in writing. Exhibitors are required to report any change/correction after closing directly to the American Kennel Club.

PRE FACE : The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of A K C 's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship.

They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.

- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the A K C bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
