Fax entries are accepted. Added fees are applied to fax entries paid by credit card or online entries that are paid by credit card through PayPal at *picalo.com* and such fees are added for use of the website for online entries. PayPal payments do not require a PayPal account. PayPal payments with eChecks are not accepted. (See reverse side of entry form).

Continuous access and use of the *picalo.com* website for event entries, payments or other purposes cannot be guaranteed, and use of the website is subject to availability. **PLEASE ENTER EARLY.**

Fax entries that are received incomplete or illegible will not be accepted. The proof of transmission is not proof for verifying faxed entries. Telephone and emailed entries are not accepted.

Entries close 6:00PM PDT WEDNESDAY, MARCH 28, 2018, at the address designated for event processing, after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing date, except as provided for in Chapter 11 Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules. Fax entries that are received incomplete or unable to be read will not be accepted. The proof of transmission is not proof for verifying faxed entries. Telephone and emailed entries are not accepted.

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds. Returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards must be made good before the dog (s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, or submits payment by credit card that is declined, will be required to pay a fee of \$25 in addition to the entry fees for which check or checks were issued or for charges to the declined credit card. The entry fee plus the \$25 shall then be paid by cash, money order, or cashier's check. Subsequent returned checks or declined credit cards from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete or entries received without correct fee amounts will not be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks including wrong information, entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.

Entries not on official AKC forms or downloaded or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form and/or not within the official AKC entry size are NOT acceptable.

The Pacific Coast Bulldog Club Awards Presentation will take place 10 minutes following the conclusion of the Saturday show

Care of SHOW SITE Whenever it shall be determined that misuse of a hotel/motel room or show site may have occurred, the AKC Event Show Committee shall convene for the express purpose of an on site inspection of the area in question.

Misuse of SHOW SITE includes but is not limited to the following:

- ▶ Smoking in non-smoking areas or rooms.
- ▶ Allowing dogs to relieve themselves in areas other than those designated for that purpose.
- ▶ **FAILURE** to clean up after any dog in your care in any area at any time.
- ▶ **ALL DOGS MUST BE CRATED IN ROOMS.** Bathrooms are not considered a crate area and are not to be used to house dogs.
- ▶ **DOGS ARE NOT** to be bathed in hotel bathtubs. Hotel towels are not to be used on dogs. Dogs are not allowed on Hotel beds/bedspreads.
- ▶ **NO OUTSIDE FOOD IS ALLOWED IN THE HOTEL.** You may enjoy outside food in your room or vehicle, NOT in the hotel show room, hallways, and/or lobby.

DUE TO THE HIGH NUMBER OF COMPLAINTS MADE BY THE HOTEL ALL ROOMS WILL BE SERVICED DAILY. AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE OR THE HOTEL STAFF ROOMS CAN BE INSPECTED AT ANY TIME.

In the event of a complaint should it be determined that destruction and/or misuse of property has occurred, the following steps shall be taken to correct the matter:

- ▶ Monetary restitution shall immediately be made to the hotel/motel by the violator(s).
- ▶ The person(s) found in violation of the hotel / motel rules or AKC rules or rules of the hosting clubs, shall be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- ▶ If suspended from AKC privileges, the offender's name(s) shall be published in *The AKC Gazette* as having violated said rules.

Novice Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Bulldogs Only. Bitches in season are not eligible to compete.

JUNIOR HANDLERS MUST PUT THEIR JUNIOR HANDLER'S NUMBER ON THE ENTRY BLANK. To obtain a Junior Handler number, call the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776 or E-mail at juniors@akc.org.

Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. By signing the entry form, certification is given that the Junior Showman does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. A recording fee of .50 cents and a Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Sec. 2). Trophies must be claimed the day of the show or be forfeited. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone and Telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries must be submitted on an American Kennel Club Official Entry Form or exact copy (both front & back) and must be signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks.
