Entries with payment checks made payable to clubs, not to Picalo SW, will incur a fee of \$10.00 per incorrect check before those entries can be accepted.

Fax entries are accepted. Added fees are applied to fax entries paid by credit card or online entries that are paid by credit card through PayPal at picalo.com and such fees are added for use of the website for online entries. PayPal payments do not require a PayPal account. PayPal payments with eChecks are not accepted. (See reverse side of entry form).

Fax entries that are received incomplete or illegible will not be accepted. The proof of transmission is not proof for verifying faxed entries. Telephone and emailed entries are not accepted.

Entries close 6:00PM CST WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2021,

at the address designated for event processing, after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing date, except as provided for in Chapter 11 Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules.

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds. Returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards must be made good before the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, or submits payment by credit card that is declined, will be required to pay a fee of \$25 in addition to the entry fees for which check or checks were issued or for charges to the declined credit card. The entry fee plus the \$25 shall then be paid by cash, money order, or cashier's check. Subsequent returned checks or declined credit cards from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete or entries received without correct fee amounts will not be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks including wrong information, entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.

Entries not on official AKC forms or downloaded or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form and/or not within the official AKC entry size are NOT acceptable.

The Bulldog Club of America and the Oklahoma City Bulldog Club do not agree to arbitrate claims for these events as set forth on the official American Kennel Club entry form.

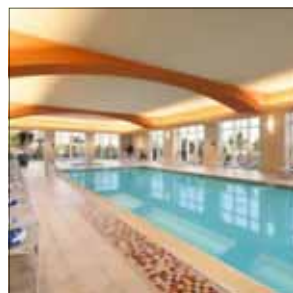

Contest winners (1st-4th place) will be based on the greatest number of points accumulated from the dog's entries and results in five categories: (1) Conformation Show, (2) Junior Showmanship, (3) Obedience and/or Rally Trials, (4) CGC and/or Trick Dog Evaluations and (5) Fun Zone Activities and/or Best Trick Contest. Dogs must participate in at least three of the five categories to be eligible for the contest. Ties will be broken by coin flip as needed. This contest includes only the shows, trials and activities held during the 2021 National Specialty week (Monday, November 22 thru Friday, November 26, 2021). All the Conformation shows and Junior Showmanship classes Monday through Friday are included as options; however, contestants will be required to choose only one show to count for contest points. The 2020 events held on Sunday will not be included in the contest. Prizes: 1st - \$200 cash, gift basket and rosette, 2nd - \$150 cash, gift basket and rosette, 3rd - \$100 cash, gift basket and rosette, 4th - \$50 cash and rosette. Point Structure:

- 1 point = entering Conformation Show*, Juniors*, Obedience Trial and/or Rally Trial
- 1 point = entering Trick Contest
- 1 point = participating in a Fun Zone booth educational activity (Scent 'n Go, Agility, Lure Coursing, Rally, etc.)
- 1 point = evaluation for CGC and/or Trick Dog titles
- 2 points = passing requirements for title in CGC and/or Trick Dog, qualifying in Rally and/or Obedience trial
- 4 points = 1st in class, 3 pts = 2nd, 2 pts = 3rd, 1 pt = 4th (Conformation, Juniors, Rally, Obedience)
- 5 points = High Combined score in Rally, High Combined score in Obedience, High Triple Combined in Rally, BOB, BOW, BOS, SD, SB, AOM, WD, WB, RWD or RWB in Conformation, Best Junior Handler.

***Conformation & Juniors Contestants must choose one show to use to count for contest points**

Scoring example: You enter a conformation show (1 point), you win first place (4 points), you win reserve (5 points), you take a CGC evaluation (1 point) you pass the CGC (2 points), you participate in three Fun Zone educational activities (3 points), you enter a rally trial (1 point), you qualify (2 points), but don't get a placement (0 points), and you enter an obedience trial (1 point), you qualify (2 points) and you get a third place (2 points) = 24 points! The more you do, the better chance you have to win!

Chapter 16, Section 1 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows "At the National Specialty the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex totals at least twice the number required for a five point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners."

AWARD OF MERIT (offered for the two Bulldog Club of America National Shows Only)

At the Judge's discretion, no more than 5 deserving Dogs or Bitches, in the Ring for Best of Breed, may receive an Award of Merit. It is not mandatory that the judge award any certificates. Each Judge of Intersex will be given the criteria for such awards. Dogs awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed and Best of Winners are excluded from selection by virtue of their higher placement. The Award of Merit shall be given following Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite, Select Dog, and Select Bitch.

Winners of these classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete in Best of Breed Competition.

***VETERAN DOG AND *VETERAN BITCH CLASS** - For Dogs and Bitches 7 (Seven) years of age and older. Open to Champions and Non-Champions alike. A dog may be entered in the Veterans Class without being entered in any other class. Dogs & Bitches will be judged separately.

**Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class.*

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES - ALL SHOWS

As the judge's decision in these classes is based on the merits of more than one dog, none of the dogs judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won this class.

****STUD DOG CLASS** - Stud Dogs shall consist of 2 get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy or the Standard for its breed. Get must be entered individually in a Regular Class. Best of Breed or some other Non-Regular class of the same show. Get only to be judged. (Neutered Stud Dogs may be entered).

****BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. (Spayed Brood Bitches may be entered).

***Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.*

BRACE CLASS - For two dogs of the same recognized breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in Brace competition must have at least one or more common owners. The dogs comprising the brace MUST BE named at the same time of the entry. If a dog which is to be part of Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered as "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual regular entry form. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as apart of a Brace MUST BE marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No.2" etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and **current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the Non-Regular classes.

- ▶ If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- ▶ If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- ▶ If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- ▶ If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and Non-Regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- ▶ If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- ▶ If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- ▶ No class dogs other than the Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

* Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

** A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

CLASSES:

Novice Class - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

Open Class - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

Master Class - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier. Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes.

For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC go online at www.akc.org. Junior Handlers's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank.

You may obtain your number by calling the AKC (919) 233-9767.

Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.
